There are three types of new ACRIB SKILLcard



Refrigerant Handler Card - White (£35 inc VAT)

This construction related occupation card is designed to register operatives competent to handle refrigerants and is valid for three years.

To apply for the card, you'll need to:

- Hold an appropriate F-Gas qualification
- Take a SKILLcard RAC health and safety test



Refrigeration/Air Conditioning Technician - Blue (£35 inc VAT)

This card reflects your qualification level and is valid for five years.

To apply for the card, you'll need to:

- Hold an appropriate F-Gas qualification
- Take a SKILLcard RAC health and safety test
- Hold an NVQ/SVQ Level 2 or be a skilled worker who's had an informal apprenticeship and hold a City and Guilds or SCOTVEC (SQA) craft certificate



Refrigeration/Air Conditioning Engineer - Gold (£35 inc VAT)

This card reflects your qualification level and is valid for five years.

To apply for the card, you'll need to:

- Hold an appropriate F-Gas qualification
- Take a SKILLcard RAC health and safety test
- Hold an NVQ/SVQ Level 3 or be a skilled worker who's had an informal apprenticeship and hold a City and Guilds or SCOTVEC (SQA) advanced craft certificate

Why do you need an ACRIB SKILLcard?

If you work on stationary refrigeration, air conditioning and/or heat pump equipment (SRACHP) the ACRIB SKILLcard will provide evidence of your qualifications and competence and may be required to access sites.

If you are a technician or engineer, holding an ACRIB SKILLcard will show employers that you are trained and competent, skilful and safe.

If you are an employer, your workforce's possession of ACRIB SKILLcards will reassure potential clients of your company's professionalism and clarify which refrigerants your technicians are qualified to work with.

More than 56,000 individuals hold SKILLcard in the wider building services engineering sector – confirmation that the cards are recognised by employers, clients and end-users.
